### **Royal Commission**

Over the next few weeks there will be more information coming out into the public arena around the findings from the Royal commission of Enquiry into Abuse in Care which has been conducted over the last 6 years. This marks the end of the largest and most complex public inquiry ever held in New Zealand. Established to respond to the significant feedback from victims of historical abuse suffered in institutional care, primarily in state care and later, after requested by faith-based organisations, extended to faith-based care also.

The report will be a very important step in the painful journey experienced by those who have suffered at the hands of others while under the care of the state or similar faith-based institutions including schools and residential organisations since 1950.

Please, if you get a chance, take notice and familiarise yourself with the discussion and the findings if possible. Take the opportunity to practice empathy and listen to the pain and grief experienced by those impacted. Our prayer is for grace, justice and hope to sooth the wounds experienced through this dark part of our nations' journey.

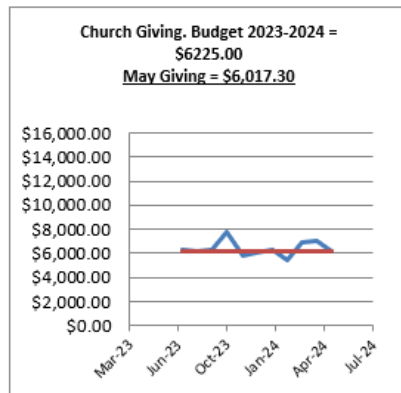
