The Parish Council met on the 16th of October at Alon's house. The main focus of the meeting was on the new building. It was very reassuring that we expect to complete the contract with Simons within budget. To save a cost overrun we have agreed to have some working bees to do things like paint the original wrought iron above the brick wall on the street corner and also to address the garden on the car park boundary. More importantly we are arranging a walk-through of the building sometime in November. The final handover date is yet to be confirmed but will depend on the final building inspection.

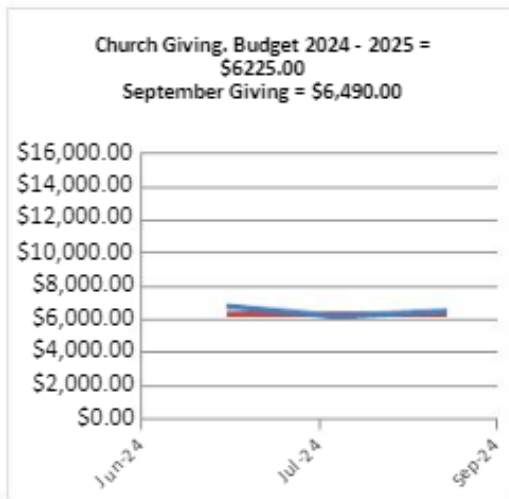
