More importantly we are arranging a walk-through of the building sometime in November. The final handover date is yet to be confirmed but will depend on the final building inspection. We will keep you posted. Meanwhile the next Parish Council meeting is scheduled for 3rd November. 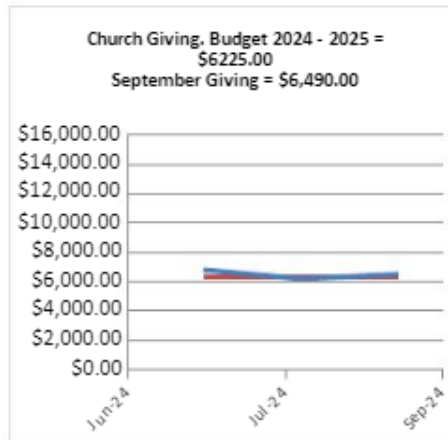
